



Giant's Causeway

Description

Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1986, Giant's Causeway is a natural reserve and a beautifully intriguing natural wonder of the United Kingdom. With around 40,000 large black basalt columns of volcanic origins plunging into the sea, the area creates a unique hexagonal landscape. This fascinating outdoor site also offers different cliff trails and other natural highlights with a history of over 50 million years.
